

EMAIL TO ELAINE OLPHERT DESIGN MANAGER AT REDROW ON
FEEDBACK FROM THE PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON 0CTOBER 24TH
2019

Dear Elaine,

Thank you for your email of the 10th December in reply to my query regarding the receipt of your replies to the comments made following the exhibition held on 24th October. This was received before notice of your two reserved matters applications 34/19/0035 and /0036.

From the exhibition you will know that there is a great deal of anxiety in the area concerning your proposals and that the Parish Council must hold a public meeting before it can send in its own response.

In your email you have said that:

'Following on from the public consultation, we are in the process of putting together responses to all the queries and comments, and are preparing to pull together a comprehensive list of responses to everyone's queries in the form of a website and newsletter. This will have lots more details about the proposals and will endeavour to answer the concerns and queries arising from the public exhibition.

We will email everyone who attended the public exhibition and those who contacted us directly to advise that the website has gone live and this should address your comments and queries.'

It is essential that this information must be received before any meeting can be held by us to consider your applications so that all are up to date with what it is that you wish to do.

As not all interested and affected people will necessarily be able to study and enlarge your proposals on a computer, please will you supply full size drawings of the more descriptive and informative plans which can then be made available at the public meeting. This will enable them to be clearly and fully understood and explained, so that unnecessary queries can be answered by us at the public meeting.

As this will delay matters slightly we have asked SWaT for an extension to the usual 21 days response time.
